

Biowaste City of St.Gallen

This belongs to biowaste:



Food waste such as meat, fish, cheese, bread and baked goods



Coffee and tea grounds, incl. filter and household paper



Raw organic remains, eggshells, fruit and vegetable waste



Garden waste, grass cuttings, leaves, shrubs



Tree cuttings and loppings (max. length 90 cm, Ø 7 cm)



Bouquets, potted plants (without soil) and Christmas trees



Feathers and hair



Small animal manures (only from herbivores)

This does **not** belong to biowaste:



Plastic bags, food packaging, coffee capsules



PET, aluminium, glass, waste paper, cardboard, textiles



Soil, ash, stones, cigarette stubs



Diapers, cat sand, animal excrements

Tips and tricks about the biowaste bucket

- Line the bucket with absorbent material (e.g. household paper)
- Empty the bucket regularly into the container
- Clean the bucket well, it is dishwasher-safe, but not the carbon filter in the lid
- Only use biodegradable waste bags with grid print (available in retail trade).
No plastic bags!
